

Would you like to communicate your science to the public?

Outreach options in Denmark mostly require you to speak Danish. But if you have a passion for scicomm, [Videnskab.dk's "Forskerne formidler"](#) offers a possibility for disseminating your research to a broad audience:

Videnskab.dk is the main news media for science in Denmark. Articles are written by journalists, but on the subsite Forskerne Formidler ("*Researchers disseminate*"), researchers write their own articles.

Now the editors offer to translate English texts to Danish, in collaboration with the author.

In addition to increasing your outreach skills, 30% of their writers report that they have subsequently been contacted by the media. You can also expect to be contacted by other researchers, citizens, companies, publishers, etc.

What can you write about?

- Your own research, e.g. your latest paper
- Research-based comments to current debates in society
- Fascinating basic stuff from your field of research
- Reports from a field trip
- Drafting citizen scientists
- A new grant; what's the current status of your field, and how will the grant help you advance it
- Your colleagues' research in your field
- Etc.
